HINDI

BEGINNERS CLASS:

- Introduction of Hindi warnmala (k, th, ga).
- Introduction of Hindi vowels (a aa i ee).
- Use of matras in consonants.
- Two letter word formation using warns.
- Reading of simple words.
- Preparing students to be able to read simple sentences of their level.

Upon completion of this stage, the student would be able to better appreciate the complexity of Hindi language, vowels and consonants. They would be able to read simple words and sentences by the use of matras.

ADVANCED CLASS:

- By now students should know the alphabets.
- Word formation of 3 – 4 letter words.
- Sentence construction, paragraph construction.
- Take dictation.
- Discuss the plot in a given story.
- Discuss stories – plot characters, theme moral.
- Culture and Heritage.

Upon completion of this stage the student would have developed a more focused approach to learning Hindi and gain a certain amount of confidence in his / her ability to deliver formal talks, dictate fluently and construct paragraph and sentences.

WORKSHOP:

Importance of Hindi: Discussion or open forum concept. Topics that can be discussed are:

- Emerging of Hindi Language in Fiji.
- Struggle of Hindi Language.
- Significance of Hindi Language.
- Difference of Fiji Hindi and Formal Hindi language.
- Learning Hindi:
 - Vowels, symbols, consonants, 2 letter word formation (with English meaning).
 - 3 letter – 4 letter word formations.
 - Introducing matras (use of matras).
