 - 2. Teentaal 16 beats
 - 3. Daadra Taal 6 beats.
 - 4. Roopak Taal − 7 beats.
 - 5. Jhaptaal 10 beats.

THEORY: Full description of:

- ➡ Different sounds (bols) of Tabla and Dagga.
- Khaali and Taali.

PRACTICAL: Students are taught following:

- How to play different Taalas (rhythmic patterns) as mentioned above.
- ♣ Ability to play Tabla Tarang (solo).
- ♣ Ability to accompany musicians (singers and instrumentalist).

These courses are designed to help students become competent in playing Tabla, Harmonium and singing.
